Our positive assessments use many of the same tests as a diagnosis for dyslexia, dyspraxia (DCD), ADHD and autism. The findings will, whilst not sufficient for a formal diagnosis, identify appropriate areas for further investigation if required and make a case for referral.

For many adults, positive assessments often come too late; many have journeyed through life believing they lack skills and intelligence.
