

How to Put a Sentence Together

There are 3 types of sentences. Simple, compound or complex.

It depends on the number of clauses.

A clause is a group of words which has one verb, conveying one message.

A **SIMPLE** sentence has one clause.

e.g. The man came indoors.

A **COMPOUND** sentence has two clauses, joined together by a conjunction or a semi colon.

e.g. The man came indoors because he was cold.

A **COMPLEX** sentence has more than two clauses.

e.g. The man came indoors because he was cold, then he decided to have a hot bath.

Once you have complex sentences you can do all kinds of interesting things with them.
